Home/School Connection

Kindergarten Information

All parents who are planning on sending their child to Kindergarten or Transitional Kindergarten within the Conejo Valley School District are encouraged to go to their website www.conejousd.org. In an effort to assist parents and guardians in the process of enrolling their child/children, CVUSD has moved to an online pre-enrollment system. You can pre-enroll at https://conejo.vcoe.org/preenrollment/.

- Registration for Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten at all CVUSD elementary schools has begun. Enrollment packets may be completed online using the pre-enrollment system.
- To register you will need to upload the following: original birth certificate, immunization records, escrow papers or lease/rental agreement and two current utility bills that show your service address and mailing address.
- A School Choice Application must be submitted if you want kindergarten at a school other than your neighborhood school.
- If you apply for School Choice and the application is approved, then the registration documents will be forwarded from your neighborhood school to the approved school.
