Please remember children should always be dressed for an active, messy day at school. Comfortable clothing that can get soiled is essential for school attire. Slip on shoes, flip-flops, or sandals can be dangerous and are inappropriate for active play. **Tennis shoes/sneakers** and socks are recommended and must be worn while at school. Please apply sunscreen to exposed skin before school. Children who attend an extended or full day of preschool can keep sunscreen on file at school. You must give a **completed permission slip and sunscreen** with your child’s name on it to your child’s teacher or any office personnel.

Please also label your child’s possessions (lunch box, thermos, containers and outer clothing). In teaching children self care, they regularly clean up their own lunches and some items can get mixed up. If you do notice another child’s containers or property in your child’s bag, notify us via email

and return them to school.

Kinder Camp students will come and go from the main front door. Our pre-K classes taught by Ms. Laura & Ms. Karen, will use their patio doors. The remaining preschool classes (Ms. Adriana and Ms. Kelly) will use the main entrance to the school next to the Newbury Oaks sign. Toddlers will use their own classroom door.

Finally, we would like to welcome back Ms. Jessica (TK teacher) and Ms. Maria (TK aide) to Newbury Oaks for the summer. We look forward sharing more details about our teachers in our monthly newsletters.

NOTICE TO ALL PARENTS:

The State of California Department of Social Services sets certain standards for the safety and well being of all children. The current requirements from this agency refer directly to the Sign-In/Out sheets that are on the clipboards outside each classroom. The state is requiring that the adult signing the child in or out do so by signing their full legal name and enter the time of day the child is accepted into the school and the time of day the child is released from the school.

These sheets are legal documents and are the only required record of the children placed in our care for the day. It is **EXTREMELY** important that you sign your child in and out. In case of an emergency and evacuation, these clipboards are our only means of knowing which children are attending school or if anyone has been picked up early.

The Department of Social Services collects a \$100.00 fine per unsigned child in a facility. In the event that we receive such fines due to lack of signatures, we will have to collect the fine from the appropriate families. Please help us keep our children safe by signing them in and out correctly. Thank you for your continuous help in this matter.
